Even George Digweed, multiple World Champion, commented, "It was some of the best Compak targets I've ever shot". Well done Deon and his team!!

Our own Tim Hubner shot an unbelievable 194, beating George Digweed by 2 targets. Feeling the pressure, Digweed dropped 2 easy going-away targets on his last range! András Szerdahelyi from Hungary came 3rd with an impressive 190.

Compak SA and the Maccauw Gun Club in Bloemfontein faced some great challenges in drawing entries to the competition. Many of the international shooting community were not familiar with Bloemfontein and the club, being in the middle of "Big Sky Country". A lot of sleepless nights were experienced by the organising committee, as well as Compak SA, to overcome this and entice shooters to enter. The members of Compak SA got together and in a momentous effort as a sports body, the most entries for an African Champs were received, from local and international shooters! A total of 47 international and 109 South African entries were received and participated.
