## Members Notification no 15 - Various matters

## 1) Compak SA Membership and/or renewal of membership-dates and period

Please note that the date for membership renewal has changed as well as the period for the annual membership:

- Annual membership commencement date: 1st of January 2019
- Annual membership ending date: 31st of December 2019
- Any new member joining Compak SA after the 30<sup>th</sup> of June of each year, will pay a pro rata annual membership fee of R500 after which the member needs to renew his membership at 31 December at the normal fee of R1000
- Membership Certificates will only be available to members once membership has been renewed and membership fees paid

## 2) National Trials and Rankings

A decision was taken on 8 November 2019 by the executive committee regarding the national trial and ranking system, and the following was decided:

- Number of trials to count towards the ranking and selection of teams for both the African Championship and World Championship (National Team and Compak SA Squad) were reduced from 5 trials to 4 trials
- MQS remains the same see below:

#### • Method to determine ranking system and Minimum Qualifying Score:

- o A minimum of four scores to count
- o A score is defined as 200 targets shot at any of the registered Compak trials
- The average of the shooters top four scores will determine his trial score
- A trial score is determined as a percentage of the high gun for the day determined over 200 targets
- The MQS for the different categories as follows:
  - Men 92%
  - Seniors 86%
  - Veterans 80%
  - Masters 80%
  - Ladies 80%
  - Juniors 88%

Men: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Seniors: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Veterans: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Ladies: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Juniors: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)

# Compak SA Team Selection

A Compak SA Team will also be selected after the last trial has been shot and the team will be selected as per the above criteria and according the rankings for the specific championship. The team will consist of:

Men: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Seniors: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Veterans: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Ladies: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)
Juniors: 3 team members (top 3 ranked shooters)

## 3) Dedicated Sport Shooter Status

A decision was taken that any member must have shot 200 competition clays (Compak Trial) to qualify for Dedicated Sport Shooter Status before being permitted to download their certificate from the website. The period in which to shoot a competition will be any competition shot in the previous year up to the current competitions. As soon as the member has competed in a competition and their scores have been uploaded to the website within the period, the system will automatically be updated, and the Dedicated Sport Shooter Certificate will be available for download.

# 4) 2019 AGM date

The Compak SA Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held at Maccauw Gun Club on the 15<sup>th</sup> February at 19h00. Further details will be communicated to all members closer to the time.
